# Audio to Go

## Be mobile with library resources and information on MP3 players

In addition to books, videos, DVDs, and other library materials, Gordon Library has many audio options:

- eAudio of bestsellers, fiction, non-fiction, radio programs, and journal articles
- Audio Tour of the Gordon Library building
- Podcasts providing information about research tools

Library tours and podcasts can be downloaded to your own MP3 player or can be checked out on a library player. Due to copyright restrictions, audio content of published books and radio programs cannot be downloaded to your own MP3 player. However, Gordon Library staff will load these materials onto library-owned MP3 players that you may borrow.



### Identifying eAudio Selections: Search the Library Catalog

eAudio books and other digital audio content can be found by searching in the library catalog by subject: **eAudio**. The library provides access to these and many other eAudio selections:

- *Amsterdam* by Ian McEwan
- *1984* by George Orwell
- *Memoirs of a Geisha* by Arthur Golden.
- *Technology Review: magazine of innovation*—monthly issues
- *Fresh Air*—episodes with NPR's Terry Gross
- Many more!

If you enjoy books on CD or cassette, search the library catalog by subject: **audiobooks**, to find items in the library's collection.

The current focus of the series is on how to use free and subscription-based information resources of interest to WPI students and faculty. Podcasts are 2-3 minutes long and include such titles as



- *MESHing with Pubmed*—this segment gives tips on maximizing your searches of medical literature
- *Liquid Propelled Research: Patent Searching Using the USPTO*—this segment incorporates the patents of WPI alumnus and “Father of Modern Rocketry” Robert H. Goddard, to explain patent search concepts
