

## **Purpose of the Interfraternity Council (IFC)**

Since 1891, fraternities at the Worcester Polytechnic Institute have served an integral role in the outstanding operation and reputation of the university. Each chapter has the right to self-governance through which they may strive to fulfill their obligation to the Greek system as a whole. To facilitate in this goal, we have set up this Interfraternity Council to coordinate the efforts of each chapter into one all-encompassing body.

This Council shall set the standard for conduct of all Greek men at WPI. The foundation for this standard comes from the basic responsibilities of fraternal organizations across the country:

- support the mission of the university
- respect the rights not only of the campus community, but also those of the citizens of the neighborhood around the university
- comply with the Campus Code and local, state, and federal laws, regulations, and ordinances
- avoid hazards and harm to people and property and minimize the risk of liability claims against fraternities and/or the university
