- Additionally, City Civ provides access to learning tools, like **flashcards** and **town meetings**, for residents to learn about civics

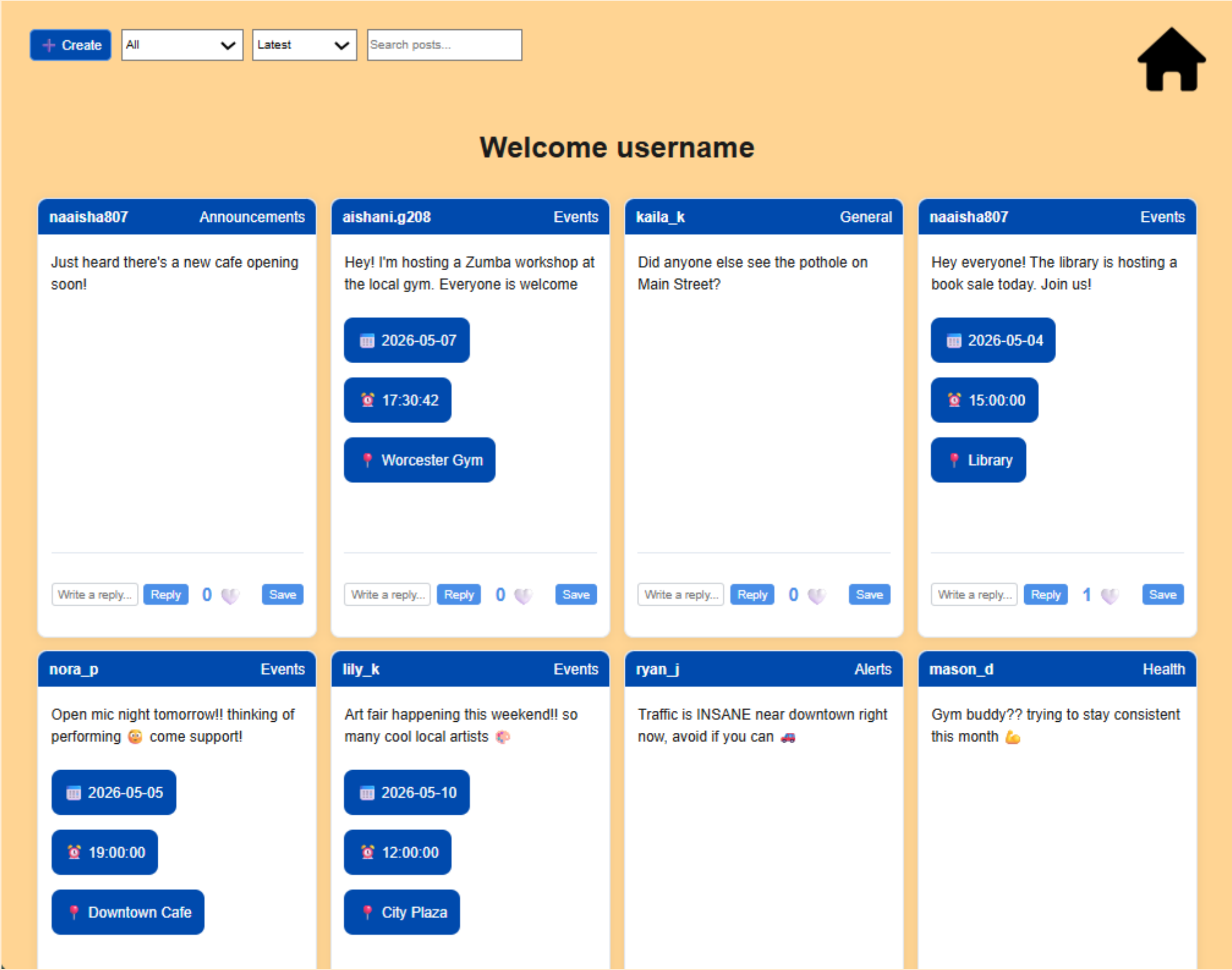
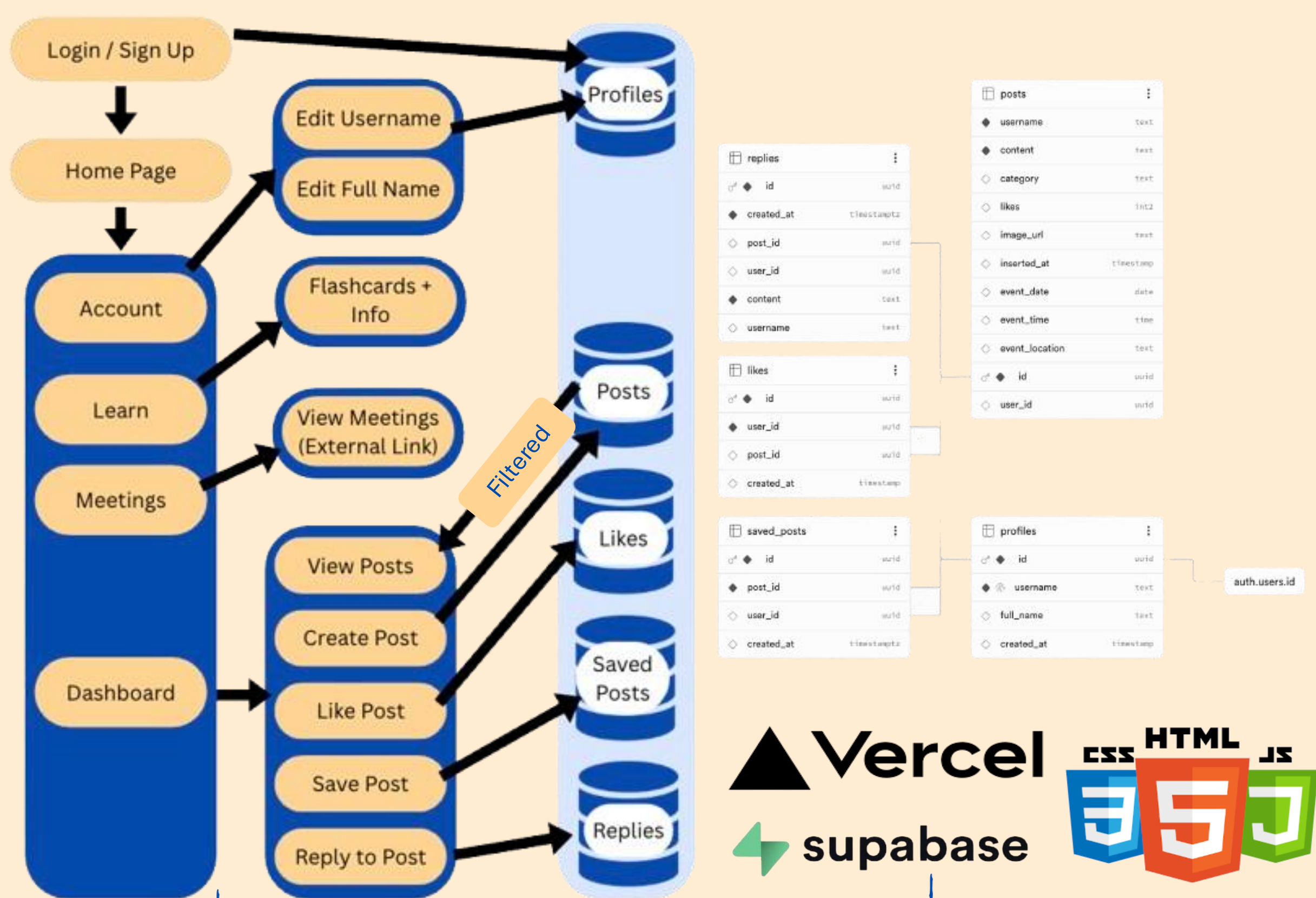
Motivation
