




What we can improve for your family


- Public Education Curriculum

How we can address it?



- We can address this by adjusting the curriculum to add **more accommodation** for students that don't learn the 'normal way'
- Our classes are more **minimized** than classes at local public schools because a lot of students in one room at once can be difficult to give **specific attention** to any of them
 - Students with ASD can be overstimulated with the number of stimuli that is going on at one time
 - We also created little **cubbies** within each classroom to **decompress** and **calm down** before coming back to class
- Students will be separated based on their learning type for efficiency
 - Audio
 - Text Based
 - Non-verbal



Classes and Daily Life




- Each student takes math, science, history/lit, life skills, explorative, and participates in specials. On wednesdays, every student participates in a communication and a reading comprehension block.
 - Explorative is a class focused on following passions and providing a structured path to being able to find out more about their own interests

Grading




- Grading is more **improvement** and **participation** based, and based on their level of ASD, their end of year portfolios is graded as well.
 - In the **participation** portion part of the gradebook, each homeroom will have **sticker charts** that correspond with each student that allows them to earn stickers to put on their charts at the end of the day
 - Each student to strive to participation **3** times a class
 - For testing, students will be graded on a **1-4 scale** across classes and they will have **specific criteria** they have to meet in order meet or exceed expectations
- For end-of-year report cards, students will have a section of **habits of mind**, where they will be graded on a 1-4 scale on **readiness, participation, and improvement**.



Floor Plan



Grade 9




Floor 2

Grade 10




Floor 3

Grade 11




