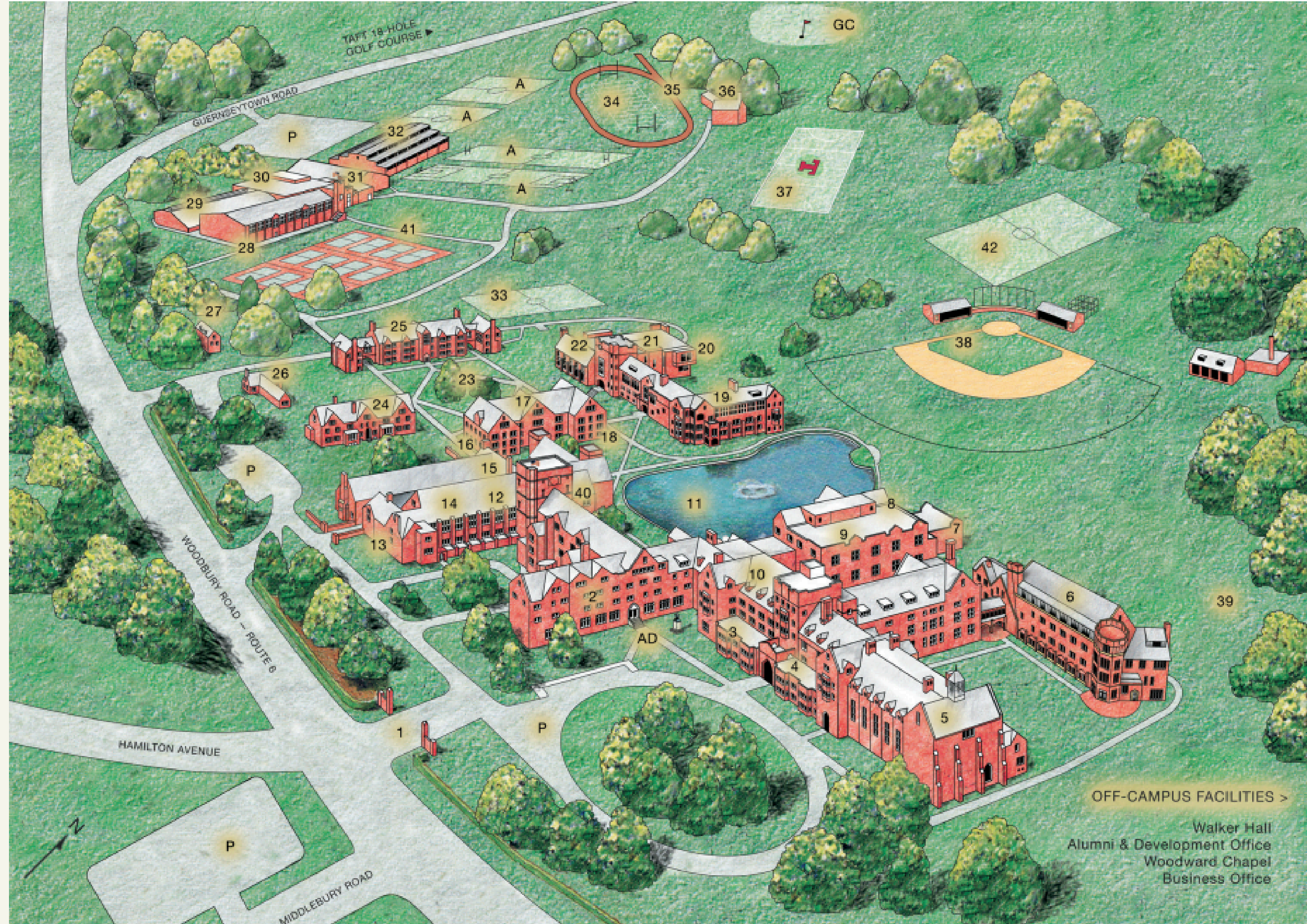


MISSION



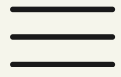

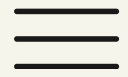

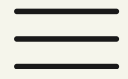

GRADES

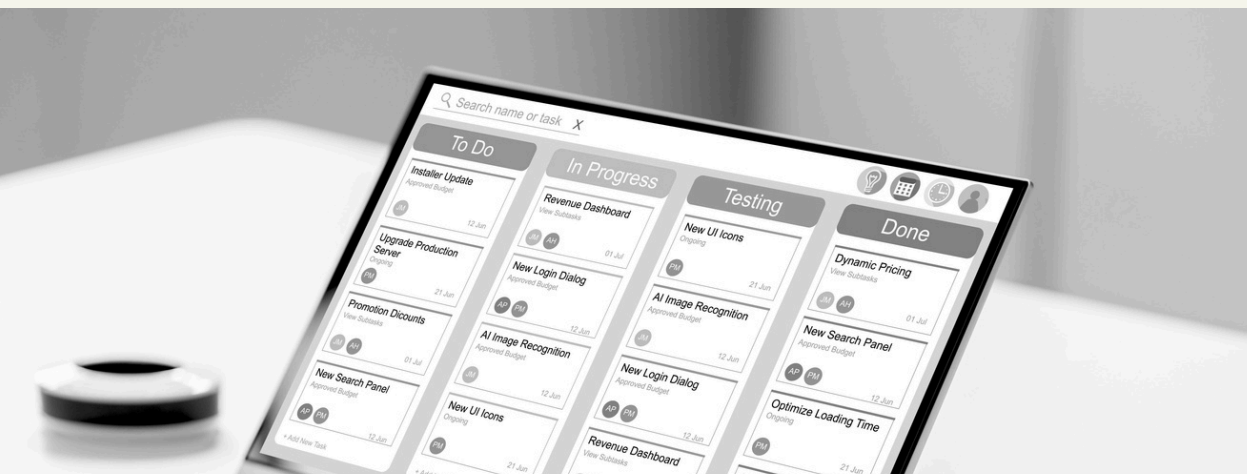
- All classes will definitively be described as Skills- Based or Content-Based
- Skills based class (public speaking, research, etc.)
 - Graded 1-3 on assignments
- Content based classes (Calculus, hard sciences, etc.)
 - Graded on content mastered, like traditional school
 - Grades would correspond to students average over the year
 - Teachers can weigh tests, projects, etc. as they see fit
